ANNUAL REPORT 2022-2023

The Motto: 'AtmanO mOkshArtham - jagaddhitAyacha'

'For the liberation of oneself and for the welfare of all!'

Our organization, founded in the year 1970 as a registered society with the inspiration of monks of the Ramakrishna Order, continues to work, upholding the twin ideals given by Swami Vivekananda.

We present hereunder the various activities undertaken on several fronts during the financial year 2022-2023: 1. Children's activities 2. Youth Activities 3. Earn while you learn programme 4. 1. CHILDREN'S ACTIVITIES

The activity of children is conducted Daily. During the year, about 60 children from the nearby locality, irrespective of caste and religion attended Samithi regularly and were actively involved in all kinds of activities. The several activities involving the children are detailed below.

A total amount of Rs.8,15,006/-, combining various heads, was spent on the Balavihar programme during the financial year. An amount of Rs.3,33,131/- was spent on providing food. Audio-visual equipment in the form of computers and monitors was added to a tune of Rs. 62,677/- Sports activity expenses were to a tune of Rs.99,926/-

Moral Classes and Informal coaching: The usual moral classes were conducted in the evenings from 4 to 8 pm for the children which include narration of moral stories from Indian culture, life and teachings of Swami Vivekananda by using multimedia.

Supplementary Food: Every evening the children were provided with supplementary food. A common kitchen run by the volunteers is being maintained in the Samithi. Everyday 4 kgs of food was served in the evening which was cooked in samithi along with fruits, juices, milk, snacks and curd. Several well-wishers and friends bring cooked food or other snacks for children regularly.



Mallakhamb: Mallakhamb is an ancient martial sport of India, wherein a wooden pole of 8 feet is used to do various acrobatics. Several of the children are learning the warrior art of doing acrobatics on a Mallakhamb. It involves

a lot of preparation in the form of exercises to make the body strong as the sport needs a lot of strength and endurance.

A special training camp on Mallakhamb: 23, 24, 25 July, 2022: A special training camp on Mallakhamb was conducted by inviting Sri Uday Deshpande ji, the legendary Mallakhamb Guru, International Mallakhamb Coach and the Founder Director and Hon. Gen. Secretary of the Vishwa Mallakhamb Federation. All the children and youth of the samithi participated in the camp. It should be noted that the children were











being trained by Sri P. Santhosh Kumar for the last three years in sport. Sri Uday ji gave training and suggestions to improve and do newer poses on the Mallakhamb. The training programme ended with a felicitation function to Sri Uday ji on 25 July. The function was presided by Samithi president Prof Chiranjeevi garu and Sri M.Dasaratha Maharaju garu visited as the chief guest.

Yoga Asana Classes: Yoga classes for the children were conducted daily by Sri P. Santhosh Kumar. Children practice Yoga regularly and some of the children have become quite proficient in the activity and are demonstrating and instructing the new children. Some of them are conducting online Yoga classes too. A few are taking it up as a profession.

Carnatic Classical Music Classes and Mridangam Classes: Three boys of balavihar were being trained in playing Mridangam. The classes were held for three days in a week. Sri Kamaraju V. Kishore garu was conducting the classes 'online' from Vijayawada. Regular classes in Vocal Music (thrice weekly) are conducted by Smt. K. Ramadevi garu. Ten children from balavihar are attending these classes. These classes are also open to children from outside. A total amount of Rs.1,67,050/- was expended for this activity.

Gardening Classes: Members of Balavihar were involved in growing various ornamental plants and learning gardening techniques like grafting and cutting etc. Shade-net houses were built by volunteers and the children were practicing the techniques by growing plants in the Samithi. An amount of Rs.3,485/- was spent on this activity.

Ornamental fish: Glass aquariums were fabricated at Samithi to show children how to make them. Ornamental fish were being maintained in them. Children were regularly engaged in the maintenance of the aquariums, feeding the fish etc. Rs.34,086/- was spent on this activity.

Earn while you learn: The children conducted a shop on Sunday mornings for the potted ornamental plants and the ornamental fish they raised and are learning the rudimentaries of conducting a store.

Bicycle repair Workshop: On 04 Sep, 2022, A bicycle repair workshop was conducted for the elder students of Balavihar under the leadership of Dr. N. Ramagopal, our Treasurer.

Hindi Examination: Chi. Mahaboob Basha attended the Rashtra exam and passed.

Karate Classes: Karate classes are being conducted by Mr M.Gopi for selected balavihar children.







Yoga Dresses: Yoga dresses were provided on Nov 9, 2022 to 43 children.

Distribution of Blankets: On Nov 23, 2022, 38 children of the balavihar were given blankets. Swami Yadunathanan-daji Maharaj, Chennai gave away the blankets.

Educational tours:

Apr 9, 2022, Girl children visited the Sarada Mission, Guntur and interacted with the Matajis and saw the activities being conducted by the Mission.

On Apr 23, 2022, the children visited Suryalanka beach to witness the release of Leatherback Turtle hatchlings into the sea.

On Jun 11, 2022 the children visited a nearby village Ganapavaram to see the activity of pottery.

Oct 14, 2022 the children visited Hyderabad, stayed in the Math and visited various places like museums etc.

On 07 Mar, 2023, twenty five children of Balavihar visited the local giant wheel.






Online classes on Robotics: Sri Burri Venkat Reddy, USA, an old student of the study circle, conducted robotics classes online for the children and also conducted a workshop in Vivekananda Bhavan on 5 Aug, 2022.

Air-Force staff: distributed gifts to children on 21 Feb 2023, celebrating the azaadi ka amrit Mahotsav.

Bharatanatyam: A Bharatanatyam teacher from US is teaching the youngest children the rudimentaries of the art.

Talent Shows: The talent show by Balavihar children was made a part of the two day Golden Jubilee conference. Children showcased their talents in physical activities like Mallakhamb, Yoga, cultural activities like Kolatam, dance, recitation from Pushpanjali book, Bhajan etc.





On the Independence Day celebrations of 2022, the children showcased the yogasanas at the Collectorate of Bapatla District.

On 03 Sep 2022, the children participated in a programme conducted by the Air Force Station, Suryalanka and conducted a programme of singing bhajan and did dance of Kolatam.

On 25 Sep 2022, the children gave a show of Mallakhamb in the prize distribution programme of the Vivekananda cultural competitions.

3. YOUTH ACTIVITIES

Free Online Yoga classes: From Vivekananda Bhavan, free online yoga classes were being conducted. Everyday from Morning 5 AM to evening 9 PM, 10 classes, each one hour duration, were being conducted, six days in a week. These classes were free and more than 200 participants from all age groups world-wide were attending and practicing and reaping the benefits of Yoga Asanas. Special classes for Pranayama and Ad-



vanced Yoga poses were also being conducted. Every class will have an Instructor and a Demonstrator. These classes were greatly appreciated by the general public. This programme is being organized by Sri P. Santhosh Kumar, Managing committee member.






Free Yoga courses: Samithi is conducting Free Courses in Demonstrating and Instructing Yoga Asanas as a part of the online and offline classes. Two courses viz., Yoga Demonstrator and Yoga Instructor were being offered at seven different levels. Enrolled candidates were given a structured syllabus prepared specially by the members of the Samithi under the leadership of Sri P. Santhosh Kumar. The candidates were expected to undergo vigorous training in both theoretical and practical aspects of yoga. Finally they have to undergo practical, written

and oral tests. Qualified students were awarded a certificate in the name of the Samithi. A video containing the performance of the candidates is made and the same is uploaded in the Youtube channel of our Samithi. The entire programme is completely free.

An intensive yoga training camp was held for the Abhigna yoga instructor course trainees on 17 & 18 of Jan, 2023 under the leadership of Sri P. Santhosh Kumar.



International Yoga Day: Yoga day was celebrated on June 21, 2022. Volunteers from samithi visited five colleges and four schools in Bapatla town and conducted a lec-dem programme on Yoga.

At 5.45 am, a special programme was conducted in the Vivekananda Bhavan. Children showcased Yoga Asanas and Certificates were given away to qualified candidates of the yoga courses. This year 13 candidates qualified as Yoga Demonstrators. Eleven members passed the Abhijna (I) level and 2 members passed Vijna (II) level.

Free Tailoring classes (Earn While You Learn): The Free tailoring classes were conducted under the leadership of Smt S. Anusha. Smt T. Anuradha is conducting the classes. Four batches of students were trained. The course duration is three months. Some housewives from the locality were trained around 18 people, out of these people 7 were promoted with certificates and a special batch for balavihar students is being conducted. 6 people are trained in a year of period, out of this 2 persons are well trained and qualified with excellence. A separate room for the sewing machines with 5 machines is arranged and a newly added another room for cloth and paper cutting purposes of tailoring classes. All the materials were provided free of charge. The qualified students would be awarded a certificate in the name of the Samithi. An amount of Rs.58,610/- was spent on this activity.

The dresses stitched as a part of training in the tailoring classes were distributed to the children.

Afforestation programme: Under the leadership of our Treasurer, Dr. Nemmani Ramagopal, the volunteers of the samithi actively planted pongamia, gangaravi, neredu and other plants in Suryalanka area with the help of Sri Mantena Dasaratha Maharaju garu. The work was mostly manual with voluntary work. Plants grown to a height of 12-15 feet in recycled plastic water bubbles were given to the public for planting in their premises.







Study Circle: Sri A. Natarajan, Secretary was conducting a study-circle to the children of the Samithi.

Financial Aid/Scholarships: In the financial year an amount of Rs.1,03,685/- was disbursed as scholarship to several needy children from the Balavihar.

Youtube Channel: Several videos were prepared and uploaded into the youtube channel of our samithi. The samithi publi-

cations like Pushpanjali, Mana Mahonnatha Varasatvam were used as the source book and videos on topics like Aesop fables, Ramayana, Vemana Padyalu, The yoga activities of the students, the songs of Pushpanjali, chanting of the Gita, music performances and practice sessions of the Balavihar children were some of the topics. The activity is organized by Amirapu Natarajan and P. Santhosh Kumar.

Book-stalls: Not conducted during this year. The old book-stall van was sold away for a nominal price as it was getting old and became unusable.

Carnatic Music programme 'Sangeetha Jhari': Suspended.

Gymnasium: A gymnasium which was arranged in the Vivekananda Bhavan is being used by the children and youth.

4. NARAYANA SEVA, SERVICE ACTIVITIES:

Free Homeo Medical camps: Monthly Homeo Medical camps were conducted. Dr. N. Aruna Kumari, DHMS, a renowned homeo-physician, was treating the patients throughout the year online and offline. An amount of



Rs.63,482/- was spent on this activity.

Saradapuri Temple maintenance:

In the month of May, 2022, the Poleramma temple at Saradapuri was repainted and minor repairs were attended to at a cost of Rs. 62,635/- A Public Address system was purchased at a cost of Rs. 13,200/-and gifted to the devotees of Poleramma temple who are conducting bhajan programmes in temples around Bapatla town.











This year, Narayana Seva (Annadanam) on the eve of Sri Ramakrishna Jayanthi was conducted in Saradapuri on 21 Feb, 2023—the Jayanthi of Sri Ramakrishna.

5. GOLDEN JUBILEE CONFERENCE

The golden Jubilee conference which was planned during 2020 couldn't be conducted because of Covid-19. It was conducted during this year on 11, 12 and 13 on Nov., 2022. This was conducted as the 3rd annual conference of Madhyandhra Ramakrishna Vivekananda Bhava Prachara Parishat. In this programme more than 500 delegates from all over Andhra Pradesh participated. All the arrangements were done by the volunteers of the Samithi. The programme was conducted in the Rotary Hall adjacent to Samithi premises. The Vivekananda Bhavan and the prayer hall of samithi were also utilized. An amount of Rs.5,21,281/- was spent on this event.

In this conference 12 Sadhus of Ramakrishna Mission and 2 Matajis from Sarada Mission, Guntur participated. They are: Swami Atmavidanandaji Maharaj, Bengaluru; Swami Sukritanandaji Maharaj, Tirupathi; Swami Bodhamaya-



nandaji Maharaj, Hyderabad; Swami Vinischalanandaji Maharaj, Rajamahendravaram; Swami Svasamvedyanandaji Maharaj, Visakhapatnam; Swami Vedavidyanandaji Maharaj, Rajamahendravaram; Swami Parijneyanandaji Maharaj, Hyderabad; Swami Yogishanandaji Maharaj, Hyderabad; Swami Bhitiharanandaji Maharaj, Kadapa; Swami Sevyanandaji Maharaj, Vijayawada; Swami Raghunayakanandaji Maharaj, Chennai; Swami Sannivasanandaji Maharaj, Kadapa and Pravrajika Bodhamayaprana Mataji and Pravrajika Divyatmaprana Mataji attended.





Youth conferences: On 11 Nov 2022, one conference for school students (topic: "Mastery of Concentration") and five conferences for college students (topic: "Take control of Your life!") were held.

The conference of school students was held in Rotary Hall at 9 am. Five hundred students from 5 schools listened to the topic "Mastery of Concentration". Swami Sukritananda ji, Swami Bodhamayananda ji, Swami Sannivasananda ji participated in this. Balavihar children also displayed the martial art of Mallakhamb in this event.

At 10 am, three conferences were held simultaneously in three colleges. In the Agricultural college, where the students of Agrl. Engg. College and College of Food Science and Tech. joined, the conference held in BV Nath Auditorium was addressed by Swami Raghunayakanandaji and Amirapu Natarajan. In the Bapatla Engg. College, Swami Bodhamayananda ji addressed the students. In the Bapatla Women's Engg College, Pravrajika Bodhamayanana Mataji and Pravrajika Divyatmaprana Mataji addressed the students.

In the afternoon at 2 pm, Swami Sannivasanandaji addressed the students of Mantena Venkatapati Raju Degree college, Karlapalem. At the same time, Swami Raghunayakananda addressed the students of Govt. Junior College, Chirala.

On the same day at 6.30 in the evening, a meeting was organized in Saradapuri (A village built by Ramakrishna Mission in 1977 with the Samithi). Swami Atmavidananda, Swami Sukritananda, Swami Bodhamayananda and Swami Sannivasananda addressed the villagers. The villagers conducted bhajan and distributed prasad to the attendees.

On 12 Nov 2023, the conference started with puja in the prayer hall at 7 am. Sri Gorrela Ramu and party performed "Burra Katha" at 9 am in the main venue, Rotary Hall. At 11 AM, the inaugural session started with the welcome address by Sri Mantena Dasaratha Maharaju garu. Senior Monk Pujya Swami Atmavidanandaji made an inaugural speech. Organizing convener, Sri Bethalam Srinivasa Raju, Jt. Secretary of the samithi, welcomed the delegates. "Sneham" ('Friendship' - a book on personality development) was released by Atmavidanandaji. Swami Vinischalanandaji gave his presidential address. Swami Sukritananda ji, Swami Bodhamayananda ji, Swa-







Swasamvedyananda ji, Swami Bhitiharananda ji gave their benedictory addresses. The session eneded with the children of balavihar showcasing the Mallakhamb.

The second session started at 2 pm. This is an exclusive women's session. Pravrajika Bodhamayaprana ji, Smt. Mudunuri Madhavi, Smt. Nayani Jyotsna spoke. Chi M. Venkateswaramma, an old balavihar student and an accomplished yoga trainer, gave a demo of Yoga asanas. The girl students of balavihar gave a show of Mallakhamb in the session. The session ended with the felicitation of the guests.

Meanwhile, from 2.30 onwards, the organizational meeting of the Madhyandhra Ramakrishna Vivekananda Bhava Prachara Parishat was held in the Dhyana Mandiram of the samithi. Swami Vinischalananda ji, Swami Sukritananda ji, Swami Bhitiharananda ji and Swami Sevyananda ji participated in the meet.

At 4 pm the third session was held with the speeches of Swami Sukritananda ji, Swami Bo-

dhamayananda ji, Swami Bo-Swasamvedyananda ji and Sri Bethalam Srinivasa Raju. The session ended with the felicitation of the Swamis.

In the evening session, Aratrikam and Bhajan were conducted by Swami Bhitiharanandaji and Swami Atmavidananda ji. The day's programmes ended with a devotional music recital by Bhagi Narayana Sastry and party.

On 13 Nov, 2023, the programme started at 6.30 am with prayer etc.

In the fourth session at 8.30 pm, the balavihar children chanted Bhagawad Gita. The candidates who qualified in the courses of Yoga conducted by samithi were given away certificates by the Swamis. Next, the balavihar children gave a demo of 200 yoga asanas. Swami Vinischalananda ji, Swami Yogishananda ji, Smt.Chillara Bhavani Devi spoke in this ses-

sion. Next, the children showcased their memory power by reciting from the book pushpanjali anything that is asked by Swamis from the book. Next a Bhajan was conducted by Swami Bhitiharananda ji .

The fifth session started at 10.30 am with the Kolatam dance of the girl children. Swami Parijneyananda ji, Swami Sevyananda ji, Sri Mantena Satyanarayana Raju, Dr.

Nemmani Ramagopal (Treasurer of the Samithi), Swami Vedavidyanandaji, Swami Bhiti-haranandaji spoke.

Before the lunch break, the swamis are felicitated in the Yati Puja and the workers of the samithi building repair work and donors were felicitated. The programme ended with lunch.

One hundred and fifty volunteers of the Samithi participated to make the Golden Jubilee Programme a success.









6. ANNUAL COMPETITIONS FOR YOUTH:

35th Vivekananda Cultural Awards Programme (VCAP): After a gap of two years, the Vivekananda cultural competitions - school level - were conducted from 10 to 18 Sep, 2022. Competitions were conducted in 22 events. More than 2000 children from local schools participated and more than 400 prizes were given away. The prize

distribution ceremony was held on 25 Sep, 2022 with Swami Hridananda ji Maharaj, Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission as chief guest and Sri A. Srinivasa Rao DSP was a special guest who spoke to the children and gave away the prizes. Rs.34605/-

Vivekananda Yoga Competitions: On 18 Dec, 2022, the Vivekananda Yoga Competitions were held. Approximately seventy students participated and the winners were given prizes.

Vivekananda Run (2 km Run) (For general public): A 2 km run competition was held at 6 am for the general public on Dec 11, 2022. The Bapatla town DSP Sri A. Srinivasa Rao garu flagged off the runners and gave away the prizes to winners.

7. PUBLICATION OF BOOKS:

A new booklet on the topic of "స్నేహం - మనిపిని నిలబెట్టేది, పడగొట్టేది" 'friendship' entitled Sneham is published during this year and released by Swami Atmavidanandaji Maharaj on the occasion of the Golden Jubilee Conference. Books to a tune of Rs. 4,23,835/- were sold during this financial year.



Daily and Annual Activities: Daily Prayer meetings were held on all days throughout the year. Vivekananda Ashtottara stotra is read on Mondays, Ramakrishna Stotra on Wednesdays and Sarada stotra on Fridays along with Sankirtan. On Ekadasi Days Ramanam Sankirtanam was conducted in the evenings. All the important celebrations like Tithi Pujas of Bhagavan Sri Ramakrishna, Holy Mother Sarada Devi and Swami Vivekananda were held with Special Puja in the morning and with Arati, special lecture and sankirtana in the On 31 Aug, 2022, Vinayaka evening. Chavithi was celebrated with an idol

made by the children. On Oct 24, 2022 Deepavali was celebrated with Lakshmipuja and crackers for all children.

Spiritual Retreats: A spiritual retreat was conducted on 5 March, 2022. Rev Swami Adhiswaranandaji Maharaj from Ramakrishna Mission, Visakhapatnam participated and spoke.

Visits of Swamis of the Ramakrishna Order: On Nov 23, 2022, Swami Yadunathanandaji Maharaj from Chennai visited our samithi.

29 July, 2022, Pujya Swami Vinischalanandaji, President, Ramakrishna Math, Rajamahen-











dravaramu visited our samithi.

Visits of Important Guests: On Nov 11, 2022, Dr Amirapu Satyanarayana, Dr S. Umadevi, and Sri Amirapu Sumanth, Advocate visited our samithi and witnessed the activities. Dr. Vikam Singh Aditya, Bengaluru, who is an important volunteer of Sarada Math, visited our samithi on May 7, 2022.

9. REGULAR LECTURES

Sunday lectures were held on the Gospel of Sri Ramakrishna as a part of the evening prayer meeting.

10. SAMITHI MAIN BUILDING REPAIR

Significant maintenance works were taken up for the main building of the Samithi. The building which was built around 40 years back. The wooden doors and windows were badly damaged by termites and exposure to sun and rain. Old teak wood was purchased and was used for making the doors of the windows. Black granite was used to make the door and window frames. Temple-like decoration was added to the windows and doors and pillars on the facade and the entire building is covered on the outside with Markapur slate stone tiles. In the inside, the electric wiring was done and the switch boards and wiring were replaced. The staircase was paved with anti-skid granite. Fresh white washing is done. The bathroom on the ground floor was refurbished and tiled. The work started on 5 Sep 2022 and was completed by the end of October of 2022. A total cost of Rs.23,76,774/- was incurred for the repair works.
